Preparing for your procedure

- Items to bring with you on the day of the procedure:
 - Completed Patient History Questionnaire
 - Completed Patient's Home Medication List
 - Insurance cards and another form of ID
 - Any payment as required by your insurance provider (cash, check, credit card)
- Bring this form with you on the day of the procedure.
- Do not wear nylons/stockings, body piercing or jewelry.
- Wear loose clothing and low-heeled shoes. Your clothes will be folded and placed in a plastic belonging bag during your procedure.
- Please make sure to follow your procedure instructions that you received from your doctor. If you should have any problems or questions regarding your procedure instructions, please contact your doctor.
- Due to sedation medications during the procedure, **you must have someone drive you home or your procedure will be canceled. NOTE: The driver cannot be a taxi, uber or lyft.**
- If you have family members that want to speak with the physician, please have them wait in the waiting room. Family waiting can check in with front-desk in the lobby.





Newport Harbor Pathology Medical Group (NPI# 1790711927 / Tax ID# 95-2659212) will be providing your pathology services if any polyps or tissue are taken during your endoscopic procedure. Please contact your insurance company **before** your procedure to better understand your benefits and coverage for preventive screening *and* diagnostic procedures that could be subject to your plan's deductible, co-insurance or copay.

Medicare does not cover preventive screening procedures.

Medicare Patients should be aware of their coverage benefits and sign an ABN (Advanced Beneficiary Notice of Non-Coverage) prior to their procedure.

General Information – Screening vs. Diagnostic

Upper GI Endoscopy - EGD (Esophagogastroduodenoscopy)

- All EGD's are considered diagnostic and cannot be billed as preventive screening.

Lower GI Endoscopy - Colonoscopy

- A Screening Colonoscopy is a procedure performed on a patient that does not have any signs or symptoms in the lower GI anatomy prior to the scheduled procedure.
- A Diagnostic Colonoscopy is a procedure performed on a patient with symptoms or a personal history prior to the procedure. This might include symptoms such as a change in bowel habits, diarrhea, constipation, rectal bleeding, anemia, etc. that are noted by your physician. This would also include a previous colonoscopy within the last 10 years with a result indicating colon polyps.

Tissue biopsies sent to Newport Harbor Pathology Medical Group will be reviewed by a Pathologist. Your insurance company will be billed using ICD10 Codes. The correct coding of your procedure is driven by your physician, your medical history and the results of our pathological evaluation.
